Sumisha Shankar, Fellow CCRT, Ministry of Culture. Spandan was an amalgamation of Yoga & Music through rhythmic movements for spreading holistic wellness. A rich tapestry of Indian classical wisdom integrating Yoga, Music & Dance principles for enrichment and education of mainstream audience.

In addition to the above events, CCRT has also organized an International Webinar on the theme of "Yoga, Rajbhasha and Sanskriti" on the occasion of International Day of Yoga, under the umbrella of "Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav", Ministry of Culture, Govt. of India, in collaboration with Bhartiya Sanskriti Sevarth Nyas, Haridwar, Uttarakhand.
