The training programmes are tailored to introduce the participants to various art forms and focus on development of their observational skills, enhance their writing and verbal skills and develop their understanding of the concept of deduction and conclusion. They help to make learning informative, interesting and fun. CCRT is implementing various Scholarship & Fellowship Schemes also to facilitate the training and research in various field of Indian Art & Culture.

CCRT has its headquarters in New Delhi and Four Regional Centres at Udaipur (Rajasthan), Hyderabad (Telangana), Guwahati (Assam) and Damoh (Madhya Pradesh) respectively to facilitate the widespread dissemination of Indian art and culture.

हिन्दी पखवाड़ा (14-29 सितम्बर, 2023)

संघ की राजभाषा नीति के प्रतिबद्ध अनुपालन के क्रम में हिंदी के प्रचार-प्रसार को बढ़ावा देने के लिए सीसीआरटी मुख्यालय एवं सभी क्षेत्रीय केंद्रों में प्रतिवर्ष हिंदी पखवाड़ा का आयोजन किया जाता है। इस वर्ष 14 सितंबर 2023 को हिंदी दिवस के अवसर पर हिंदी पखवाड़ा का उद्घाटन किया गया, इसमें विशेष अतिथि के रूप में श्री रमेश कुमार गंगेले (कवि एवं साहित्यकार) को आमंत्रित किया गया। इस अवसर पर श्री ऋषि वशिष्ठ, निदेशक, सीसीआरटी ने श्री गोविंद मोहन, सचिव, संस्कृति मंत्रालय का संदेश पढ़कर सुनाया। इस समारोह में कार्यालय के सभी कार्मिक उपस्थित हुए एवं क्षेत्रीय केंद्र भी ऑनलाइन माध्यम से जुड़े।
