Dear Sir/Madam,

As you are aware that the Centre for Cultural Resources and Training (CCRT) is one of the premier institutions in the country working in the field of "Linking Education with Culture". Its main objective is to organize a variety of training programmes for in-service teachers from Primary to Senior Secondary level, teacher educators (including DIET Lecturers) and administrators in order to emphasize with need of integrating Cultural Inputs in Pedagogy.

CCRT has been implementing scheme of "Training of teachers", under which some previously CCRT Trained Teachers who have been doing good work are selected and further trained to act as **District Resource Person (s)**. In the previous years, the DRPs also given financial assistance to conduct 3 days' training programme, local teacher under the guidance of their Principal and the concerned DEO/DDPI/DIoS/DD/CIoS. However keeping in view of the same and subject to the availability of their services will be utilized to train not only local teachers with all working teachers 1000-1200 school children from their own district to extend the CCRT's initiatives in 'Cultural Education' at the grassroot level under **Extension Services and Community Feedback Programme (ESCFP)**.

At present, CCRT is organizing a 03 days Workshop on "**Cultural Inputs in Curriculum Teaching**" from **June 24-26, 2026** at **CCRT Headquarter, Plot No-15-A, Sector-07, Dwarka, New Delhi-110075, Email: ddevl.ccrt@nic.in** for its previously trained teachers who are further trained to work as District Resources Persons (DRP) of CCRT.

I am happy to inform you that Ministry of Culture has approved the proposal of CCRT for organising programmes/workshops for school children on the theme "**350 years of the Martyrdom of Shri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji**" in 200-250 Government/Government-aided schools across the country. For this approved project CCRT has been entrusted with the responsibility of organizing a nationwide educational and cultural outreach initiative in schools across the country through its trained teacher network, District Resource Persons (DRPs), Regional Centres, and associated educational institutions.

In view of the above CCRT has given the following key responsibilities to implement the programme at grass-root/district level.

- CCRT shall undertake a nationwide outreach initiative aimed at reliving and reaffirming the historical and spiritual association of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji with specific places of significance, while simultaneously disseminating his teachings and message to locations not directly connected with his life and travels. The said outreach programmes shall be curated and coordinated through its Headquarters and Regional Offices, with the active involvement of District Resource Persons, teachers, and other educational functionaries.

- b. Under the proposed programme, ten districts in each participating State shall be identified for coverage, and five schools in each such district shall be included under the outreach initiative. In the event of non-availability of suitable schools in any district, schools in an adjoining or nearby district may be included so as to ensure optimal utilisation of the programme outreach. Accordingly, the programme shall extend to fifty schools in each participating State, aggregating to a total coverage of two hundred and fifty schools across the country.
- c. In each selected school, the designated District Resource Person shall make a structured presentation on the life, teachings, sacrifice, and enduring message of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji, drawing upon the approved exhibition content prepared for the purpose. Such presentation may be delivered either through digital display on smart boards or other audio-visual means, or through adapted printed formats in the nature of flip charts or flip calendars, depending upon local facilities and institutional readiness.
- d. The presentation sessions shall be followed by suitable educational and participatory activities for students, including quizzes on the life and legacy of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji, classroom board decoration activities incorporating informative content relating to him, and short writing exercises on the theme like "Five Things I Learnt from the Life of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji."
- e. While organizing events Local Gurudwaras must be consulted and appropriately associated at the planning as well as execution stage of each event to ensure full conformity with the principles of 'Rehat Maryada'. The commemoration is a solemn observance in memory of the supreme martyrdom of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur ji, hence all programme components shall reflect the dignity and sanctity of the occasion. Any dance, reenactment or performance inconsistent with the solemn character of the commemoration, or likely to hurt sentiments, to be strictly avoided.
- f. It shall be ensured that no actor portrays, represents or impersonates the Sikh Gurus or members of their families in any play, film, dramatization or stage presentation organized under the commemoration. If possible, Seminars, lectures and academic discourses may also be organized, with due involvement of scholars of 'Gurmat Vichaar, to promote informed understanding of the life, teachings and legacy of Sri Guru Tegh Bahadur ji.

### **The Objectives of the Programme**

The proposed programme seeks to:

1. Disseminate the teachings and legacy of Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji among school students.
2. Promote constitutional and humanitarian values including religious freedom, tolerance, courage, and sacrifice.
3. Integrate cultural education with classroom learning.
4. Encourage creative expression through art, craft, and cultural activities
5. Create nationwide awareness through the active participation of teachers and District Resource Persons.
6. Promote the spirit of "Viksit Bharat 2047" through culturally rooted value education.

The DRPs shall:

- Coordinate with identified schools.
- Liaise with Government & Government-Aided Schools
- Liaise with local Gurudwaras and community representatives.
- Conduct structured educational presentations.
- Organize student participation activities.
- Ensure observance of dignity and sanctity of the commemoration.
- Submit photographic and narrative reports to CCRT.
- Maintain participation and attendance records.
- Facilitate local publicity and outreach.

## Proposed Creative & Educational Activities

The following structured activities are proposed to be undertaken in each selected school:

i) Educational Presentation Session, ii) Heritage Quiz Competition, iii) "Five Things I Learnt" Reflective Writing Activity/ storytelling, iv) Classroom / Board Decoration Activity/ story telling activities, v) Poster Making Competition, vi) Exhibition Corner / Cultural Learning Space for organizing art & craft activities on the above theme of Life and teachings of Guru Tegh Bahadur Ji, vii) Community Interaction Session, viii) Seminar / Lecture Session (Where Feasible), ix) Pledge / Value Education Session.
