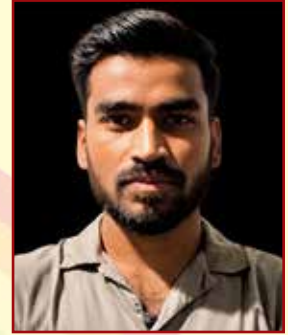
Mr. Mukesh Kumar
